1. *If your declaration covers donations you may make in the future:*
 - *Please notify us if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.*
 - *You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying us – it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.*
2. *You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give).*
3. *If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains tax equal to the tax that we reclaim, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).*
4. *If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.*
5. *If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask us by telephoning 029 2052 4150. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.*
